WHY DID MOST OF THE COUNTRY DROP THE 11+ IN THE 1960S?

- Because a one-off judgement in a short test at the age of 10 or 11 is a bad idea. All the research suggests this is entirely the wrong age to judge children's talents
- Because dividing classmates and siblings into different schools damages friends, families and communities
- Because results are better in areas where local children are educated together
